
THE SEIS HOMEPAGE: WHAT DOES IS SAY?

CURRENT STATUS




Students

POST MEETING: CALPADS ALERTS AND AFFIRM/ATTEST

IEP finalization may create some errors that need attention. The CALPADS Alerts graphic will let you know how many alerts you have and in what areas.



WHAT'S COMING UP?

The SEIS homepage also has information about upcoming caseload activity. The Meeting Alerts snapshot shows which IEPs are coming up (plan reviews, eligibility reviews, initials, and 30 day placements). This snapshot also shows the breakdown of how many IEPs are on time and how many are currently overdue. NOTE: All unaffirmed IEPs will show as overdue if they are not affirmed within their timeline window.



The SEIS News snapshot will have any new information on trainings, updates to SEIS, and any planned maintenance shutdowns. The Local News snapshot will have any announcements or updates from the SELPA office. This may include reporting timelines, error checks, or anything that is specific to our local schools.
