## Home Instruction

- Provides an alternative education program that is available to all students across all grade levels.
- Programs are voluntary
- For SpEd students, Independent Study must be stipulated in the IEP and must be developed and approved prior to the placement of the student in independent study.
- Provides access to general education curriculum for students with temporary disabilities
- The responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify the school of the request, or of the student's presence in a qualifying hospital.
- Medical documentation of need and return date is required.

- Home Instruction is considered a placement on the continuum of services for SpEd
- Student must have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 plan.
- Placement is the decision of the IEP team.
